GOTEAMS STRONG SCHOOLS START WITH MEI

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a. Discussion item 1: School Strategic Plan

I. Strategic Plan and Priorities Review:

The GO Team reviewed a presentation from Principal Blair highlighting the Strategic Plan key performance indicators from the 202504-2025 school year and the start of this school year. The scores showed slight growth from the previous school year. The GO Team discussed Reading and ELA results. Lafreddie Smith discussed how the implementation of small groups and using IXL at home yielded great results for his daughter.

II. SMART Goals

The GO Team discussed SMART goals for the 2025-2026 school year aiming for a minimum of a 5% increase by the end of 2025. Focusing on SWD students Looking to grow from 19% to 24% for general ed and 0% to 5% for SWD students for ELA. For Math, increase from 23% to 28% for general ed. And 0% to 5% for SWD students. Increasing attendance from 49% to 65% for CCRPI.

b: Discussion Item 2: Data Discussion

- I. MAP Results MAP results were shared. Overall, 35% of students are not proficient. Math 52% 5th graders not proficient and ELA 50% of students not proficient.
- ii: **GMAS Scores Georgia Milestone scores were shared.** Very little increase. Big shifts in staff assignments. Placing teachers strategically. Moving stronger teachers to 5th grade to address low performance. Science scores show only 1% increase, Replacing novice teacher on the grade level with a stronger teacher. Increase instructional time with STEM Lab teacher providing additional support.
