a. 45 Day CIP Update



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Principal Momon discussed that we have a district walk every 45 days. As a result of the walk the plan is for teachers to focus on planning rigorous and critical thinking activities. Plans will also be adjusted to include higher order thinking questions, such as compare and contrast and T4 instruction. The focus will also be on building literacy skills.

In Math the focus is building the students numeracy skills. Teachers will be given PD training on Envision Math and lesson rehearsals. For whole child intervention we are monitoring minutes to make sure each student meets their goals. A new lesson plan implementation has been put in place to increase rigor. Students will take the Winter MAP test after Thanksgiving Break, and then we will discuss those results.
