- A. Continuous Improvement Plan Presentation
 - Where We Are

Strategic Plan:

Our strategic plan is the guide for the work we're doing in the school. By monitoring the plan and ranking priorities, we can all work towards the common goals. Using the priorities in the strategic plan, the school leadership team developed a Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) for the current school year.

The team reviewed the presentation. We decided the statements are still relevant and we will keep them.

Timeline for Growth

Fall 2021 – Go Team Developed 2021-2025 Strategic Plan

- 1. Summer 2022 School Leadership completed Needs Assessment and defined overarching needs for SY22-23
- 2. August 2022 School Leadership completed 2022-2023 Continuous Improvement Plan
- 3. Sept.-Dec. 2022 Utilizing current data the Go Team will review and possibly update the school strategic priorities and plan
- 4. Before Winter Break Go Team will take action (vote) on the rank of the strategic plan priorities for SY23-24 in preparation for budget discussion

The team decided to focus on the following SMART Goals:

- Improve the proficiency rates of students in grades 3-5 by 6% in ELA by June 2022 on GA Milestones.
- Improve the proficiency rates of students in grades 3-5 by 6% in Math by Junes 2022 on GA Milestones.
- Improve family wellness survey questions to exceed a 3.94 rating.





The team decided on the following 8 School Strategic Priorities:

1. Improve the percentage of students achieving at proficient and distinguished levels on GA Milestone

2. Improve Tier instructional strategies in Mathematics and ELA

3. Improve identification procedures for Tier 2 and above

4. Become an authorized IB PYP World School by 2022

5. Implement an Intervention Block for ELA & Math

6. Build teaching capacity using effective instructional coaching strategies

7. Increase certifications and endorsements among staff

8. Create a positive and healthy school environment where students strive, teachers enjoy coming to work, and the community trusts

The team decided to include the following Strategies

- School-wide implementation of Fundations, Lucy Calkins, and Eureka Math
- Provide professional learning sessions focused on curriculum programs
- Conduct weekly data meetings and rehearsals focused on Tier 1 content
- Hire and retain an intervention specialist to oversee processes Tier 2 and above
- Conduct professional learning sessions designed to increase program awareness and philosophies
- Observe and monitor the implementation of the Tier 1 instructional block
- Hire and retain turn around reading specialist and Math Master Teacher Leader to support teachers with instructional strategies
- Promote certification and endorsement opportunities in staff communications.
- Conduct weekly house meetings and host monthly events for families to engage in
