Open Swing Seat: Dr. Andrew William; CEO of VEA Eye Professionals located in the heart of Cascade Heights. Dr. Williams has volunteered at the school numerous times and has been a financial donor for the past two years.

### **School Improvement Plan Updates**

- The 2021-2022 CES School Improvement Plan was created by key members of the school improvement team to include administrators, instructional coaches, teachers, and parent liaison.
- The final plan was submitted to the district on September 2, 2021 for approval
- The 3 main improvement goals of the school are:
- 1. The percentage of students in grades 3-8/9-12 scoring proficient or above in reading/ELA will increase from 10% to 16% in June 2022
- 2. The percentage of students in grades 3-8/9-12 scoring proficient or above in math will increase from 12% to 18% in June 2022
- 3. Create hub of resources available to families and train staff by Dec 2021, IOT increase the family wellness component of the family engagement survey with an average mean of 3.94 or above by May 2022.
- Strategies that included specific action steps that will be taken throughout the school year were stated within the plan; in addition to a short term action plan for the first 45 days of school.
- Once the plan is finalized it will be made available to the Go Team
