  - IX. Mr. Neal, 5<sup>th</sup> grade teacher, will be self-contained. He will teach his class all subjects to assist with the changes that have occurred within the 5<sup>th</sup> grade team.
  - X. The team discussed how a few roles will be reconsidered for the next school year. This topic will be re-visited in the spring.
  - XI. APS' cleaning vendor, 3H, is not cleaning the building as they should. Feces and urine is being left in some restrooms. No one is vacuuming/mopping. The GO Team can push for the money given to the current vendor to come to the school so that a new contractor can be hired to provide excellent cleaning services that's fitting for our students.
