- Disruptive behavior during a Go Team meeting may result in removal from the meeting and school property when applicable.

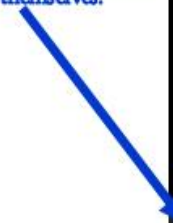

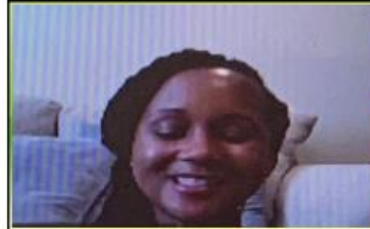
