FILL OPEN COMMUNITY MEMBER SEAT

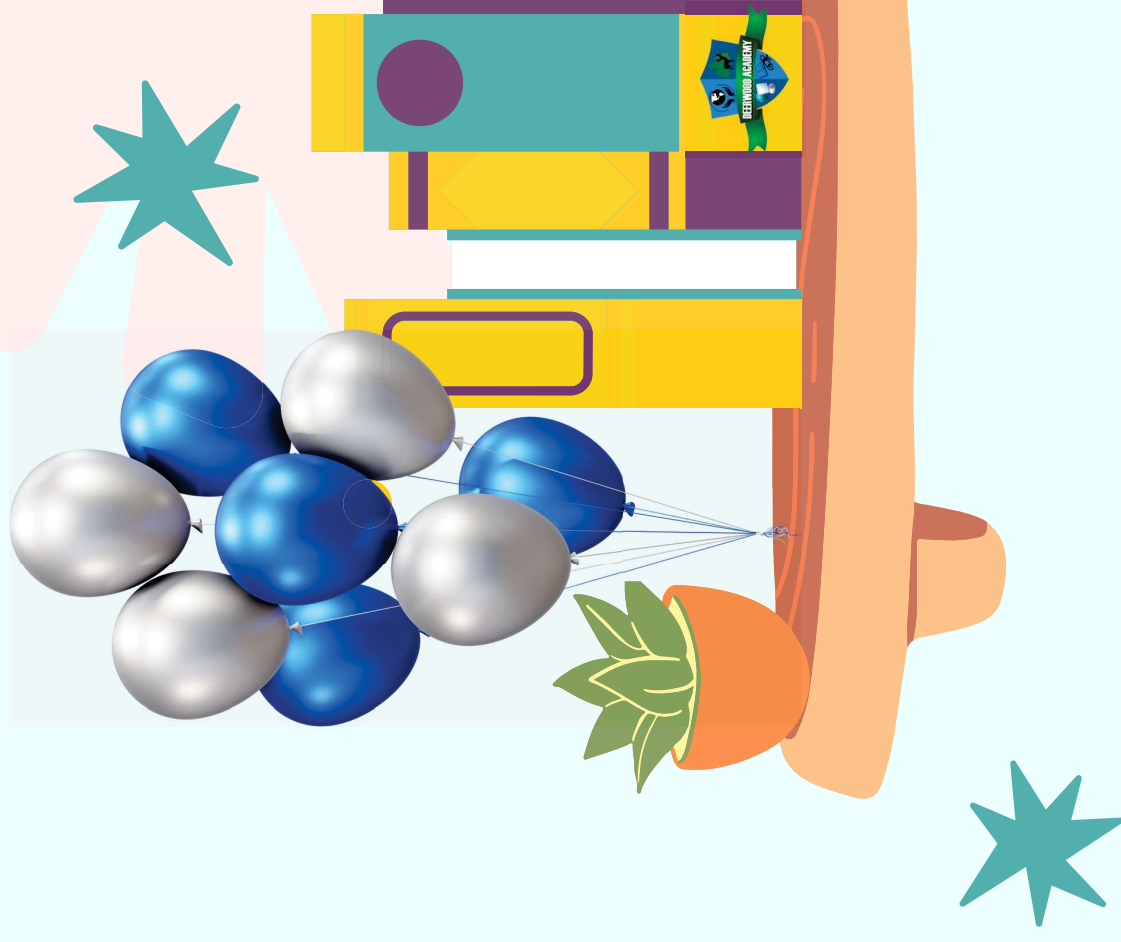
- The Principal brings forth the nominations for the vacant and open community seats.

IV. Discussion Items (add items as needed)

- Discussion Item 1: 2024 Spring MAP Results- The school had a 2% increase in the area of development in reading. The school had a larger increase in math. Deerwood Academy had a higher percentage of scholars meeting and exceeding their MAP growth goals from fall to spring assessment. 50% of our SLD students exceeded their growth target. 75% of our Hispanic population met or exceeded their MAP Goal. 49% of scholars met or exceeded their Math Goals.
- Discussion Item 2: Needs Assessment- What does this data tell us? We are moving in the right direction and we will continue to work on increasing student growth. What good news is there to celebrate? Our MAP data predictions project that we will meet our SIP goals. We exceed our MAP target goal in reading. 50% of our students with disabilities exceeded their growth goals. What are growth opportunities? The gap is closing between Hispanics and students in reading. The gap is closing between SLDs and all student in math. What trends do we see in the data? We will continue to internalize new math skills. Suggestions from the moving scholars from professional to distinguish.
- Discussion Item 3: Transportation Discussion- Discussed some safe walking trail suggestions for the scholars from the Pth Foundation. The Pth Foundation has been hired to provide a city safe walking/ riding trails around the city of Atlanta. They will have more in person meetings they are working with the neighborhood planning outreach meeting.

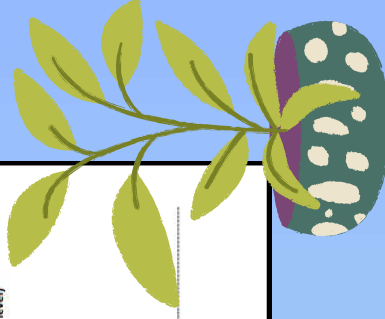

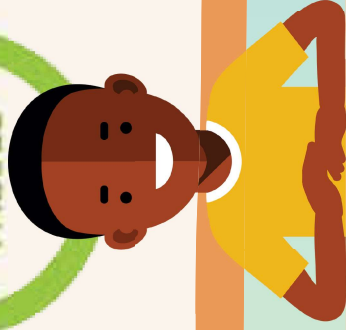

Elect Go Team Officers

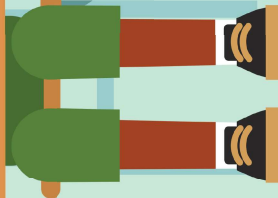
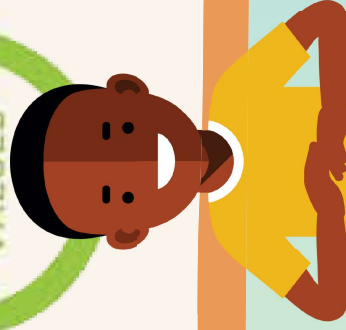
- Nominations do not have to be seconded.
- A member may nominate themselves.
- A member may nominate more than one person for any position.
- A member may decline a nomination during the nomination process.
- Members may not serve more than 2 consecutive terms in the same officer position at the same school.
- Nominees do not have to leave the room during the nomination period or when a vote is taken.
- If there is more than one nominee per elected office, each nominee will be offered an opportunity to share why they should be elected to the seat.
- The newly elected officers will assume their position starting at the conclusion of this meeting and serve for 1 year until a new officer is elected.
- All voting members have only one vote per seat.

REVIEW & APPROVE PUBLIC COMMENT PROTOCOL



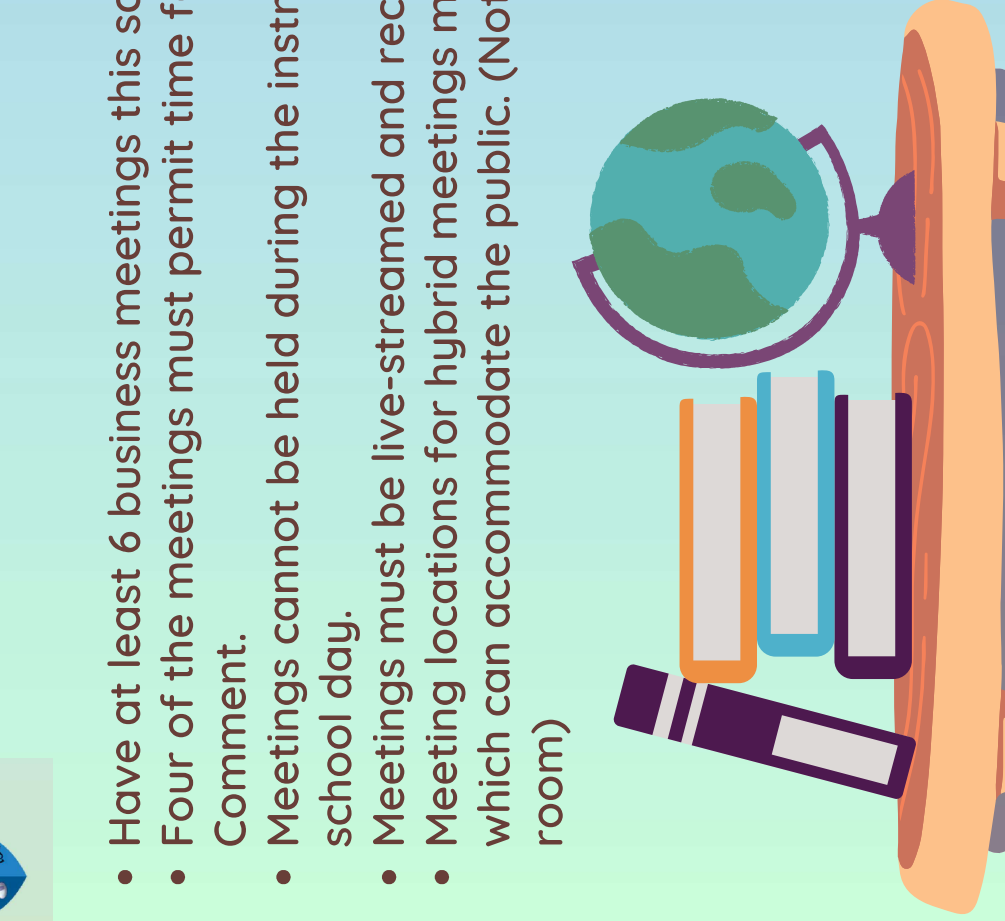
- Opportunities for public comment shall be provided at least four (4) times in a school/fiscal year and noted on the GO Team's webpage and meeting agenda;
- GO Team members will **not** provide responses or engage in direct conversation during public comment;
- Each GO Team will determine a consistent method for receiving public comments and for parents and other citizens to sign up to address the team;
- **At least 20 minutes** of time will be allotted for the public to make comments at meetings where public comment is permitted; and
- The public will receive at least 2 business days' notice of the Public Comment Protocol.





GO TEAM MEETING CALENDAR

- Have at least 6 business meetings this school year.
- Four of the meetings must permit time for Public Comment.
- Meetings cannot be held during the instructional school day.
- Meetings must be live-streamed and recorded.
- Meeting locations for hybrid meetings must be places which can accommodate the public. (Not a conference room)



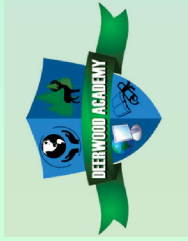

We will follow the agenda as noticed to the public and stay on task.

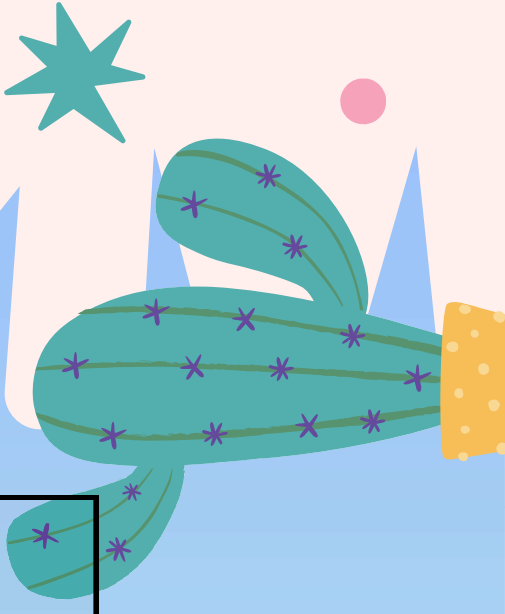
We will be respectful of each other at all times.

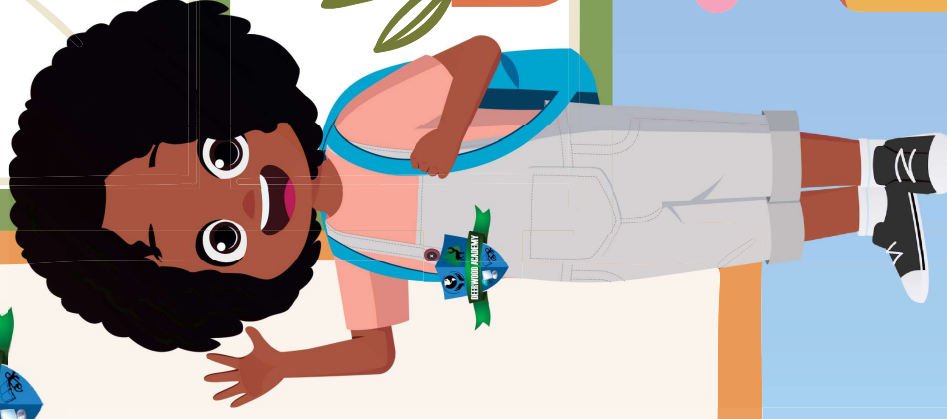

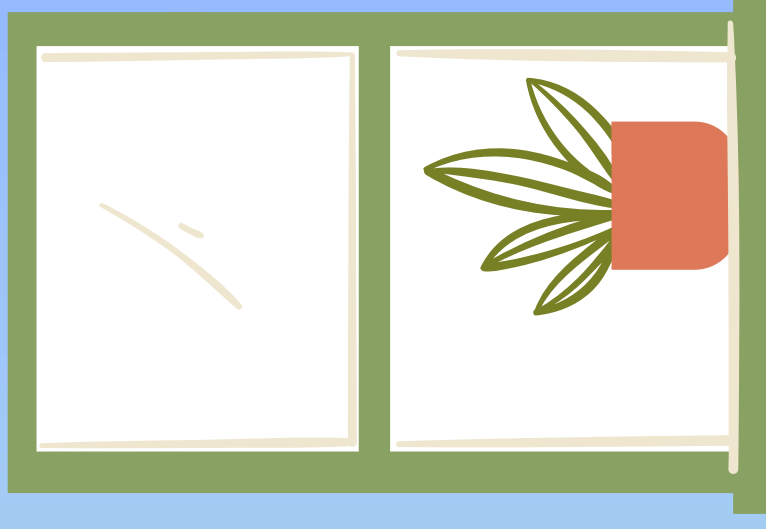
