CIP GOALS 23-24

(CONTINUOUS IMPROVEMENT PLAN)

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above in **Reading/ELA** will **increase from 12% to 15%** and **decrease the percentage of students scoring beginning from 58% to 55%** on the 2024 **GMAS**.

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient or above in **Math** will **increase from 10% to 13%** and **decrease the percentage of students scoring beginning from 61% to 58%** on the 2024 **GMAS**.

The percentage of students meeting the **CCRPI** criteria will **increase from 61.8% to 64%** and the average daily attendance rate (**ADA**) will **increase from 91% to 93%**.


Increased Proficiency & Above 2023 GMAS



J.W. Dobbs Elementary Parent FAQs:



Q: Why are students still marked absent with an excuse?

A: Legally, we have to mark students absent if they are not present at school.

Q: Can parents sit in the classroom and observe?

A: Parents can sit in a class for 30 minutes with advance notice to the teacher and front office staff.

Q: Can parents eat lunch with their children?

A: Due to increased cases of Covid-19, parents are not allowed to eat lunch with their children at this time.

Q: Can students bring a lunch and get a school lunch?

A: Yes, students can have both, and all students eat in the cafeteria. Please be reminded that teachers have duty-free lunches and cannot warm up food for students.

Q: Is Spanish Available?

A: Yes, Spanish is offered virtually to fourth and fifth-grade students.

Q: How does the school support students who are behind?

A: Students who are behind will receive extra support through daily intervention, the MTSS process, small group instruction, and EIP services.

Q: Can parents come in and volunteer?

A: Yes, parents can volunteer. However, a background check is required.

Q: How does the school/district communicate with parents?

A: District information can be found on the APS district website. The school communicates through Dojo, Thursday folders, Robo Call, and agendas.






