
#### What's the Root Cause?

Students are making minimal progress towards or achieving grade level proficiency on reading/ELA standards

Students are making minimal progress towards or achieving grade level proficiency on Math standards.

Students are chronically absent from school.







There is a need to establish an instructional framework for reading instruction.

There is a gap in teacher understanding of data driven practices surrounding instruction in mathematics.

There is a need to collaboratively develop a plan to promote positive student attendance.

#### Action Steps:

Literacy and Math	Attendance
1. Monitor consistent use of an established instructional framework and expectation for using curriculum resources.	1. Monitor Tier-1 school-wide PBIS implementation
2. Monitor the use of Common Formative Assessments and the response to student and teacher data.	2. Monitor CARE Team Meetings to ensure wraparound services are aligned and impacting positive student outcomes
<b>3.</b> Monitor a coaching and feedback cycle that ensures consistent feedback and coaching based on observation to build teacher capacity.

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




