### **IV.** Information Items

### a. Principal's Report

### i. Peek into our School Day

Dr. Spencer shared that the school has adopted new math standards that have brought up some challenges, however we are persevering each day. Students are allowed to with manipulatives to grasp concepts. Teachers are working hard to be prepared to be able to redelivery the new math standards. Dr. Spencer shared that teachers are feeling more confident with teaching the new math standards.

Dr. Spencer also shared how we are doing regarding engaging our families. She shared that the school hosted an ice cream social event for parents to come in and read and eat lunch with their student, and afterwards they ate ice cream.

### ii. School State Update

Dr. Spencer shared that the projected enrollment at the beginning of the school year was 335 students. However, on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of school there were 288 students enrolled. Leaving a difference of 47 students and because of that difference she was owed \$-244,071.00. However, because of different departments such as Title 1 family engagement, finance department, and a carryover of unspent SY2023 funds we were able to pay a portion of the funds. This resulted in us having to lose \$17,561.60 to APS. Dr. Spencer shared that there is a vacant paraprofessional position that was not filled that was budgeted last year to work with students. However, now there are tutors in the different classrooms it allows her to use the funds for paraprofessional position toward the \$17,561.60.

*iii.* Assessment Overview



### 1. GA Milestone Assessment Result

Dr. Spencer shared and compared the scores for the year of 2022 and 2023 in reading, math, and science. Dr. Spencer shared some of the gaps that appear in the chart. Also, she shared that we grew 3% in the beginning level between 2020 and 2023 in ELA scores. Now, we are working on target instruction and personalized instruction to decrease our beginning level learners by 6%. We also looked at the students with disabilities GA milestone comparisons data.

### 2. Fall MAP Results

Dr. Spencer shared how MAP works and how as a school we use the data. Dr. Spencer shared that we are working to decreasing our beginning level learners by 6% and increase of distinguish level learners by 5% by the end of the school year. Dr. Spencer also shared she will share the continuous improvement goals in our next meeting.

### iv. Fall Map Fluency Results

Dr. Spencer shared how the MAP fluency chart is read and work. Dr. Spencer shared that some scores are missed from the results due to APS graphs not reporting it as of now. However, at our next Go team meeting Dr. Spencer stated she will have a better grasp on how students did.

vi. STEM Update

Dr. Spencer shared that the Carver Cluster adopted STEM as the signature program and as of now we are at the beginning phase of our certification. Our focus is the learner's profile and the qualifications of a STEAM learner. Dr. Spencer also gave a visual of what incorporating STEAM in the classroom looks like. Dr. Spencer shared how teachers receive PL's to learn how to apply STEAM in the classroom.
