### VI. Discussion Items

- a. **BudgetDevelopmentPresentationforFY21-22**:
  - i. M Wheeler presented Budget Development Process PowerPoint
    - 1. Reviewed process from last meeting
    - 2. Budget is \$4,276,275
    - 3. Focus on classroom size reduction
    - 4. Went through puts and takes from previous budget
    - 5. Full time nurse to hourly nurse, district budgeted 0.5 nurse. Can use a nurse 5 days a week, and save money
    - 6. Hourly to full time PE teacher
    - 7. Part time to full time Art teacher
    - 8. Losing Spanish teacher to Jackson full time
      - a. Want to consider teaching ASL instead (American Sign Language)
      - b. Could help with low performing readers
      - c. Howard Middle will teach ASL
      - d. Lose Spanish all together
    - 9. No one to pair with for band teacher, hard to find 0.25 band teacher
      - a. Few kids participate in band program
      - b. Replace with hourly dance position
    - 10. Hourly to full time clerk
      - a. Used to have 2 clerks, with COVID did not bring back the 2<sup>nd</sup> clerk, but still have work load to support full time
    - 11. Just found out we're receiving \$184k CARES federal funding
  - ii. M Jones asked how many days a week would have access to ASL
    - 1. Share 0.5, need to work out schedule
  - iii. M Jones asked, What grade levels will have access to ASL?
    - 1.  $2^{nd} 5^{th}$
  - iv. M Jones asked, Band position being eliminated, what about instruments through grant?



- 1. Instruments stay in building, belong to school. May fund music in future years, hard this year because band teacher got bought out to other school.
- v. M. Jones asked if dance will be offered every day, and to which grades?
  - 1. All grade levels
- vi. D. Jones asked, will nurse be there all day, every day?
  - 1. Yes
- vii. D. Jones asked what option for boys alternative to dance?
  - 1. Boys like dance too, but offer chorus and general music. If geared correctly, boys enjoy dance too.
- viii. D. Jones asked, do hourly workers get benefits?
  - 1. No, just paid for hours they work. Could look to bring some para on full time depending on funding.
  - ix. J. Alter asked, teachers requesting specific software, any requests not able to fund?
    - 1. No, able to fund all
  - x. J. Alter asked, is there a way to measure student demand of special classes?
    - 1. Limited in what we can offer, based on course number. Discuss and balance with other cluster schools. Need to continue through (matriculate) to middle school.
- xi. J. Alter asked, broadly, student mobility, advocate specific resources to student mobility?
  - 1. Addition of full time social worker, gear questions toward mobility rate, and address.
- xii. A. Wu asked, is CARES act a one time slug of funding?
  - 1. Is part of 3 year plan, can spend over 3 years. Possibility of additional funding next year, unknown.
- xiii. M. Wheeler said the budget has received a thumbs up by HR, Supervisor, next is Go Team, can forgo next meeting and vote today
  - 1. M. Jones asked if alters meeting number per year
    - a. A. Wu said, only need 4 meetings, extras are baked in
- xiv. Motion to vote on budget today by D. Jones, T. Dorsey seconded, vote to approve motion was unanimous
- xv. Motion to approve budget by A. Wu, J. Alter seconded, vote to approve motion was unanimous
  - 1. Budget was approved, motion passed
- b. **Grady CAT Feedback**:
  - i. A. Wu presented



- ii. About 2 weeks ago, open records request to APS on records for plan for former Inman Middle School, temporarily being used for Morningside while they do repairs
  - 1. District had to gather, even if in draft format
  - District presented draft of redrawn boundary lines, only meant for discussion, developed by operations ground, had not been discussed or reviewed by others.
  - 3. Due to pandemic, no change since March 2020
  - 4. District needs to determine decision process ASAP in order to support community comment and feedback
  - 5. M. Wheeler said Hope Hill is only negatively impacted if there was a 4/5 academy, due to enrollment drop
  - 6. M. Wheeler said should support if:
    - a. HH remains in Grady Cluster
    - b. Remain diverse community school
    - c. Don't close HH

- i. Superintendent will be having cluster conversations, M Wheeler asked that team disseminate
- ii. At 42% back, up from 38% 87 to 90 show up, some revert back to virtual, projected 125 for last quarter
- iii. Teacher vaccination coming up
- iv. Summer academic recovery, district is doing 4 week, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, loss of learning, 150 kids identified, designed 8-1245 academic work, 1245-245 enrichment, Ms Mccrary site lead, teachers hired to do academic piece, at school, transportation and meals provided, can I student not come for academic but for enrichment Wheeler to find out. Due to pandemic. District is funding
