- **Report from work Session held on October 27**
 - A. Ms. Taylor and Ms. Marquez gave a brief summary of the meeting. The meeting notes are uploaded under the Parkside Go Team tab.

Discussion Items

- I. **Discussion Item 1:** Review proposed SMART goals and strategic priorities (as a starting point provided by Principal Foster) and discuss next steps for Work Session scheduled for 11/10.
 - We will discuss the goals and strategic priorities during the scheduled meeting
 - The team decided that we should finalize the vision and mission statement during this meeting and then develop aligned goals and priorities.
 - Ms. Porter-Johnson shared the vision she created - An innovative community school where lifelong learning encapsulates a diverse population of students who are inspired by not only their peers, teachers, staff and the community but also to do extraordinary deeds in the world. My thinking was that I wanted the vision to encompass new ideas, advanced with in the school setting.
 - The team decided to merge the current vision and add the language from the suggested vision. The team worked independently to merge the two vision statements to create one. The Go Team finalized the vision as stated: A beloved community school where a diverse population of students are inspired by their teachers and peers, who together build a foundation for lifelong learning and engagement in their community and world.
 - One of the goals is centered on behavior and suspension rate.

Information Items

- A. **Principal's Report on attendance and discipline**
 - The average daily attendance rate for Parkside is 91.8% school. Parkside's daily attendance rate is above the district average of 89.8%. The state reports attendance with students missing 10% or more days they are enrolled in the school. We have 161 students who are falling into this category. Once these students are enrolled in the school the report should remove them from the list.

- We have 86 students at risk of missing 10% or more days of school. Highest attendance rate is 4th grade at 92% and 1st grade 91.9% - with the lowest daily average attendance rate.
- Parents are called daily about student attendance
- We have a traveling trophy for attendance.
- Most of the absences are due to Covid regulations (quarantine etc.)
- The state does not recognize excused and unexcused absences.
- We want at least a 90% daily attendance rate at the end of year for CCRPI.
- Our daily suspension rate is 0.01%. We have suspended 1 students thus far. We are working hard to find alternatives to suspending our students. We have not had any major infractions to warrant suspension this year.
- Should behavior be one our smart goals since the percentage is low. We think it is too early to determine if this has been solved. We want to continue to work towards keeping this number low.
