

Strengths	Opportunities
White students are performing well in ELA and Math. (85% ELA) & (74% Math)	45% of Black students are performing at the Beginning Level (1) in ELA
Students who are not economically disadvantage are performing well in ELA and math.	46% of Black students are performing at the Beginning Level (1) in Math
48% of ALL students are performing at Proficient and above in ELA	26% of White students are performing at the Beginning and Developing levels in Math
18% of SWD students are performing at Proficient and above in ELA
