- A. **Discussion Item 1:** Budget - Review budget/staffing proposals for 2022-2023 school year.
 - Mr. Foster gave a recap of the 2022-23 SY Budget. Parkside has been allocated with 6,744,000.00 dollars.
 - During the last meeting the GO Team set the school priorities for 2022-23
 - 1. Increase the number of students reading on grade level by the end of 3rd grade.
 - 2. Strengthen students conceptual understanding of math
 - 3. Develop and implement a plan to address student's attendance.
 - Cares Act allocation - \$234,000.00 would like to continue using the fund to have hourly paraprofessionals in the classrooms. We will have a total of 10 paraprofessionals.
 - Foundation – If the school community decided to develop a Foundation, we could possibly use the money to fund the paraprofessionals beyond the 2023 SY.
 - The school district will continue to fund the annual fee for our IB signature programs and the coordinator salary. The trainings are funded by the school's general funds budget.
- B. **Discussion Item 2:** Committees - We proposed two advisory committees in Spring 2021
 - 1. Family Engagement Advisory Committee and
 - 2. Equitable Tracking, Labeling, and Grading Advisory Committee.
 - Collaborate with school and community members
 - Add information for document

The committee discussed the proposal of two advisory committee. Through the discussion the members felt this would be a large undertaking to commit to at this time. We all believe it can be done and the committees are needed.
