Ms. Grant addressed questions from the team.

Q: Is the idea to build upon the foundation that's been laid out and not to put a new one in place? There are some functional pieces that need to be fixed.

Q: Idea about candidate? When do you want to make a decision? Working to create a timeline. July 1, 2020 would be the ideal time to hire. The search will begin by Nov. There are four dates in October where the Board would like to hear from the community about what they want to see from the next superintendent. Use the platform, "Let's Talk," to discuss the superintendent characteristics. The board will serve as the search committee.

Shared ideas to think about for strategic plan: ACHIEVEMENT, Signature Programs

Q: With Let's Talk, is there a way to be anonymous? Yes

Q/S: We can control how the money is spent. It's a bit more equitable. We cannot control foundation money.

Q: Are the ideas for night cleanup crews on the radar? This is a common issue.

Discussion Item 2: 2020 Strategic Plan

What's the plan for planning?

Ideas: Focus on school culture; not sure if SEL will be enough; what are the action steps? Budget? Is there a process where the parents and teachers share input into the plan? It could be a discussion point during faculty meetings. Do a gap analysis around big buckets (concerns). As of now, we're focused on student achievement. *Doannie Tran will take charge of this action.*
