Discussion Items

- A. **Discussion Item 1:** Looking ahead to 2022 Milestones testing (This will be the first time this test has been administered to all 3rd-5th graders since 2019)
 - Administered May 1 – May 13, 2022 for 3rd-5th students (3rd-4th Reading and Math and 5th Reading, Math and Science). All students will not be testing on the same days. We will check to make sure devices are checked before the assessment begins.
 - 5th will only take Math, ELA and Science only
 - Georgia as asked to have the 2022 scores used as a baseline year. If approved in June, then we will not generate a CCRPI score for the year. We will look only at the student achievement levels proficient and higher.
 - The climate survey does not impact the CCRPI rating. It is usually used for the school star rating.
 - We have taking the MAP assessment 3 times this year and the students have completed assessments on the digital platform. If the MAP score is a correct indicator we are headed into the right direction. We will have areas of growth as any school would.
- B. **Discussion Item 2:** Updates on Academic Recovery Program for Summer 2022
 - The district sent about 160 students recommended for the ARA Summer program. The program is open to all students who apply. Begins June 1 and June 30
 - 5 day full day program - Morning Reading and Math instruction and afternoon enrichment activities.
 - Application are slowly coming in at this time, but we will push for families to apply after spring break.
- C. **Discussion Item 3:** Go Team candidate declaration for 2022-2022 Team
 - Four parents are registered for the Go Team
 - We have two staff members to apply
 - We will have a community member seat available for the upcoming term

- Student performance data -spring administration of MAP begins. Mr. Foster will bring the data to the team during the next scheduled meeting.
- Attendance rate - 97.9 Daily attendance rate 92.3% and 23.7% chronic absences suspension rate is 0.03%
- BESS (Behavioral and Emotional Risk Index) - 82% Normal Risk, 13% Elevated Risk, 6% extremely Elevated Risk - Survey given to the 3rd-5th students. Teachers complete the survey for K-5. We look at the questions and the answers to determine the level of support and what needs to be done for that particular student. Parents will receive the reports on Thursday.
- PUMP Program (Powering Up My Potential) - 5 Days a Week (9:30-10:00)
 - Intervention Groups - i-Read, READ 180, Do the Math)
 - Targeted Groups -
 - Bubble Group - Study Island
 - Enrichment Group - Mentoring Minds
- Mask are optional - Approximately 50% of students are still wearing masks.
- All students and staff members are testing on Mondays and Thursdays weekly
- We have moved back into the lunchroom
- Most students are well behaved and are adjusting, some are having a hard time and we are addressing this as needed.
- What are we doing on the front end to help parents understand the importance of getting students to school? We are going to be proactive and speak with families early and ensure that we are catching the attendance issues early.
