 - During the summer the leadership team will meet to revise the document and use the information to support the 2022-23 school year.
 - We had over 100 families that responded and we believe we have a good number of representation and data we can use.
- D. **Discussion Item 4:** Principal's Report - MAP Test Data - Mr. Foster shared a PPT (attached)
 - MAP Data from spring - We look for growth from winter to spring and overall yearly growth.
 - Parkside falls in the top 10 for the district for MAP Growth Achievement (8th) right below BPA in our cluster.
 - 28% Proficient and 30% Distinguish
 - The data show how we compare to the district and other schools
 - Math - Fall to Spring 43% Did not meet targeted growth (includes students who started at the 99% , those who made little growth and those who made no growth. 5% met the target, 53% exceeded expected target.
 - Reading - 55% met or exceeded and 45% did not meet the expected growth
 - District Growth Quadrant Math - Parkside High Achievement High Growth
 - District Growth Quadrant Reading - Parkside High Achievement High Growth
