IV. Discussion Items

a. Continuous Improvement Plan

- I. Goals for the 2024 SY
 - To increase the percentage of all students who score proficient or above by 5% from 50% in 2023 to 55.5% on the spring 2024 EOG in ELA
 - To increase the percentage of all students who score proficient or above by 5% from 48.1% in 2023 to 53.1% on the spring 2024 EOG in Math
 - To decrease the number of chronically absent students by 5% from 19% in 2023 to 11% by spring 2024.
- II. Strategic Plan Goals
 - To increase the number of students in grades 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in reading from 30% in 2019to 47% in 2025 on the Georgia Milestones assessment.
 - To increase the number of students in grade 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in math from 29% in 2019 to 45% in 2025 on the Georgia Milestones assessment.
 - To increase the number of students, absent less than 10% of the days enrolled to 85% by spring of 2025.
