#### IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1**: **Continuous Improvement Plan** The 45 Day Check-in, Mr. Foster shared his meeting presentation with Dr. Goodwine (Associate Superintendent). Mr. Foster discussed the action step taken based on the goals identified on the CIP. 1. We are implementing a 30-minute intervention block (8:00-8:30) 3 days on reading and 2 days on math. Using the HMH platform. 2. Implementation of the FUNdations Phonics program in grade K-3 30-40 minutes daily. 3. Strategy and skill based small group instruction for 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade (using close reading strategy to target needs-based skills). We have formed a 3<sup>rd</sup> grade EIP classroom, maximum class size is 14 students with a full-time paraprofessional. Implemented Guided Reading focused small group with K-3 classes. 4. Math implementation Reflex math, structured math framework. 5. SAC Team meets weekly to track and discuss attendance (traveling trophy, announcing classes with perfect attendance, 10-day challenge). **(Presentation linked)**
- b. **Discussion Item 2**: **Fall ACES (Accountability Collaboration Equity and Support presentation** Mr. Foster presented this information to the Superintendent, cluster principals, directors, and other district personnel. Parkside's current enrollment 562 (PK-5), No staff vacancies, 3 first year teachers, cohort 2 of personalized learning, IB authorized school, 97 gifted students, 47 talented and developed students. Shared fall MAP data (**Presentation linked**)
