 - Strengthen students conceptual understanding of math.
 - Develop and implement a plan to address student attendance.
- II. SMART Goals
 - Smart Goal # 1 Literacy To increase the number of students in grades 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in reading from 30% in 2019 to 47% in 2025 on the Georgia Milestones assessment. 2023 50% (Goal Met)
 - Smart Goal # 2 Mathematics To increase the number of students in grades 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in math from 29% in 2019 to 45% in 2025 on the Georgia Milestones assessment. - 2023 48% (Goal Met)
