## **Action Items:**

- a) 2018-2019 Budget:
  - 1. Foster presented budget. Provided copies of budget PowerPoint for reference. Sent all GO Team members slide with the only substantive changes on 2.27.18.
    - \$5M+ budget for 2018-2019 School Year
    - Priorities (as set by GO Team):
      - o Address allocation re: Math, Literacy, & SEL
        - Added half time Math Coach
        - Changed IB Coach to half time
        - Looking into software to support math in 3-5. The cost will be covered under the tech line item in the budget.
        - SEL changed to half time—Foster retains the flexibility to shape how that looks (i.e., every morning or certain days a week)
        - Adding Reading Lab. Will support lowest 25% of students—they will do 45 minutes each day. Also purchasing Lexia software.

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### 2. Questions & Discussion re: Budget

- Dave King: Where is gardening on the budget?
   Foster: Not addressed in strategic plan. But still included as "other." Allocation remains the same as last year.
- Foster: We removed the computer lab para.
- Foster: Facilities will come do a walk of building soon to discuss what spaces
  are suitable for classrooms. At that point, decisions will be made about how
  many (if any) pre-K Parkside will have in the 2019-2020 school year. We need
  more space, especially with the number or kids being identified as ESE.
- King: I think it's also important to have a plan for growth moving forward. What happens when we've used all the readily available rooms?

### 3. Budget Vote:

- · Lathan moves to accept budget.
- King seconds.
- Budget unanimously passes.

## Discussion

#### 1. Lockdown Drills:

- Lee: Parents need more information re: lockdown drills.
- Foster: Teachers need to frame conversation appropriately, in ways that are not frightening to kids.
- Lathan: Maybe this is an SEL opportunity or an opportunity to involve Ms. Brown (the school counselor).

#### 2. GO Team Nominations:

- King: Is there a way for district to direct people to next steps?
- Dubose: Information is online.
- Diane Jacobi (District GO Team office): We are currently verifying candidates. The we'll send out election packets. The declaration period is extended to FRIDAY, MARCH 2.
- Lathan: Parkside plans to have candidate forum. Foster will likely moderate. Questions will be submitted in advance.
- King: Voting is March 20-26. We will need to have forum before voting begins. Maybe there should be a discussion with interested parties before the forum to discuss the actual time commitment & responsibilities involved.
- Lathan: When is the earliest time we will have a defined list of candidates.
- Jacobi: Next week.
