- Start of the school year
 - a. Stakeholders have seen the start of the new year as something positive
 - b. Could be a result of great planning last year for this year
 - c. We were projected for 580 kids, we're now at 545. With not meeting projected enrollment, after 15 days we may experience levelling. Information will be shared in Sept. meeting
 - d. Renovations:
 - i. The computer lab has now transformed into two smaller rooms.
 - ii. Speech now has its own learning space along with some special ed. classes.
 - e. All classrooms are now being used. The FIRM now houses the gifted classroom.
 - f. Uniform compliance:
 - i. Monitored closely this year.
 - ii. This will be a part of our community gatherings topics. Classrooms will be recognized for the % of students wearing them.
 - iii. Most of our kids are wearing them, though. The shirts were limited to two colors, but the color of the bottoms remained the same.
 - g. Grant Committee Report:
 - i. Before we begin to look for more resources, there will be a survey distributed by the GOTEAM f or ideas.
 - 1. The parents will also submit ideas. One question is open ended about experiences that they would like to see for their child(ren). The questions may be asked during PTA or parent pick up. Nothing too formal.
 - 2. Volunteers will walk around and ask parents for their input.
 - 3. This committee is open for other ideas.
 - 4. An online version may be created through Google. There are several ways to gather the information. (use of Google form, Survey Monkey, etc.)
 - 5. Tori was working with Ms. Green to order materials for the "peace corners" within the classrooms and science materials.
 - 6. Representatives from the Georgia Coalition for Public Education presented a grant opportunity for schools. The grant ranges from \$500-\$5000. It's a community grant that wants us to partner with community members. There is NO DEADLINE for this grant.
 - h. Action Items:
 - i. Motion was made by Foster. It was moved by Colvin and seconded by Mickler to change the time.
 - ii. Adjustments may be made to the meeting time after all committee members have been added to this team
 - iii. Parents that are new to Parkside...
 - There's a push to get them to stay here for the duration of the school year and not leave after 2nd grade

 - 3. We need to understand why and put some action steps in place.
