V. Information Items

- a. Principal's Report (Report is posted on the Go Team page)
 Continuous Improvement Plan The continuous improvement plan was created by the 2021-2022 Go Team members. The school developed the Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) to align with the board goals. Our SY 2023-2024 goals are as follows:
 - increase the percentage of all students who score proficient or above by 5% from 50.5% in 2023 to 55.5% on the spring 2024 EOG in ELA.
 - To increase the percentage of all students who score proficient or above by 5% from 48.1% in 2023 to 53.1% on the spring 2024 EOG in Math.



- To decrease the number of chronically absent students by 5% from 19% in 2023 to 14% by spring 2024.
- Attendance: Our current attendance rate is 95.3%.
- MAP DATA 2023 Spring Map Data Results. The data is as follows:

- **Enrollment** We currently have 601 student's Pre-K-5th grade. All classes are at capacity and all classes are functioning well with the current student population.
- **Staffing** Our current staff consists of 2 Pre-K (2 Paraprofessionals), 5 Kindergarten (5 Paraprofessionals), 5 First Grade, 5 Second Grade, 4 Third Grade, 4 Fourth Grade and 3 5th Grade.
- Leveling We were projected to have 530 students and as of day 15 we have 543 students. We gained \$107,135.00 because of the increase in enrollment. We are going to use these funds to purchase a paraprofessional to support reading, math, and in-school suspension. Digital resources, media supplies, teacher training, and school supplies.
