- IV. Discussion Items
  - a. Discussion Item 1: Continuous Improvement Plan The strategic plan was created by the 2021-2022 Go Team members. The school developed the Continuous Improvement Plan (CIP) to align with the goals.

#### The CIP Goals

- To increase the percentage of Black students who score proficient or above by 3% from 18.3% in 2022 to 21.3% in the spring 2023 EOG in ELA.
- To increase the percentage of Black students who score proficient or above by 3% from 11.7% in 2022 to 14.7% in the spring 2023 EOG in Math.
- To decrease the number of chronically absent students by 5% by the end of the 2023 academic school year.

#### Fall Map Data

The MAP assessment is taken three time a year in reading and math. The Fall is taken with 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> grade in the winter you will see Kinder and first included. (The presentation is attached with specifics from the fall MAP Data Results).

The families would like to have quick access to the data <u>APS Insights</u>. The school will also put this link on the website as well as in the Thursday school communication.

b. Discussion Item 2: Parkside Foundation – Ms. Silton and Ms. McEwen spoke with the team about the two options, creating our own or going through the Parent Booster <u>We Know Booster Clubs</u> | Parent Booster USA. Some members would like to go with the Parent Booster because of the parent community moving from the school and the Parent Booster would be a quicker route to getting started. The cost is \$500.00 and approximately \$350.00 per year to keep it going. The school community would create team to move forward with this work. This is not a GO Team decision. The parents wanted the GO Team to support this initiative.





## V. Information Items

Principal's Report – Our school student population projections were 518 and our current enrolment is 520. The funding for the school increased, and carryover funds are available. Mr. Foster would like to use these funds to hire an additional 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher.

The strategic plan that was created by the 2021-2022 Go Team was shared (attached). The school has three smart goals by 2025. The goals are as follows:

- To increase the number of students in grade 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in reading from 30% in 2019 to 47% on Georgia Milestones assessment.
- To increase the number of students in grade 3-5 scoring at the proficient and above levels in math from 29% in 2019 to 45% on Georgia Milestones
- To increase the number of students, absent less than 10% of the days enrolled to 85% by spring of 2025.

Mr. Foster shared the Glows and Grows thus far:

### Glows

- The percent of students proficient and above increased from 35.2% in 2019 to 42.5% in 2022 in ELA.
- The percent of students proficient and above increased from 29.2% in 2019 to 34.3% in 2022 in Math.
- 80% of white students scored proficient and above on ELA
- 75% of multi-racial students scored proficient and above on ELA

### Grows

- To increase reading proficiency scores for all students in reading/ELA.
- To increase math proficiency scores for all students in math.
