Mr. Tuberquia discussed process for adopting uniforms as well as establishing the committee. Mr. Tuberquia nominated Ms. Muhammad-Williams to Chair the committee; Ms. Muhammad-Williams accepted. The Committee will close out on 12/18/25.

b. 2025 – 2030 Strategic Plan Development

Mr. T presents 2020-2025 Strategic Plan, 2025-2030 Strategic Plan Goals.

Specials Teachers Working to support curriculum.

Discussion about ATSCI status and our Special Education growth and population. Ms. Blackwell explained that we are working hard to identify students that need support and that about population growth and we have already been approved for additional support.

Mr. Tuberquia further discussed the school's smart goals, including proficiency goals for Math and ELA and attendance.

Discussion about Mission and Visions alignment. Agreed that no changes be made.



Ms. Blackwell discussed continuous improvement goals. Aiming for 5% per year instead of the standard goal to push our students.

Asked about having an additional goals. Explained school discipline plan, SEL, and PBIS. Noted that we don't have major discipline issues outside of 4th grade which is being address. Discussed culture and climate and needed improvement.

Satu: Agrees with behavior issues, but would like to see goals related to SEL, collaboration, and community.

Mr. Tuberquia: Agrees with climate, looking at a climate goal.

Ms. Blackwell: Discussed Second Step and SEL slides from Mr. Brodi. Agrees with adding a goal regarding SEL Learning. And discussed District training in Restorative Practice.

Mr. Tuberquia discussed the training with Dr. W and Mr. Brodi. Spoke highly of the experience and the intention of sharing that with students and other staff members.

Ms. Blackwell explained that those teacher will be Restorative Practice Ambassadors. Discussed helping students to work together.

Ms. Drew added that she agreed the training was great and would like to see all teachers receive that training.

Group agrees to add an SEL component to our climate goals.
