- A. APS Insights is a platform that supports informing the public of the school data.
- B. Our 3 year average is a 59.6. Our 2017-2018 CCRPI scores is 71.4. Our school CCRPI school rating comparison is 5.9 points higher than like schools. There is still much work to be done in ELA/Math Proficiency. We still made progress in reading and math. Student growth three year average is 63% in ELA and 68% in Math. Our Climate Stars dropped from 3 to 2 stars.
- C. Our school was named a Beating the Odds School. This is our second year being on the recognized.
- D. Our most challenging area of readiness is in literacy according to the data. We have implemented guided reading practices to help improve literacy scores and are



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utilizing Fountas and Pinnell. For Content Mastery, we have come a long way but we still have work to do to push developing learners to proficient and proficient learners to distinguished learners. We hit all but one of our performance flags. We met our target in some areas, and we doubled in economically disadvantaged. We have over 15 students in students with disability subgroup. We have to continue to work on tier 1 instruction.
