- d. Our final budget is \$4,409,267. Money was lost due to the small school formula this year. Some changes that have been made for the upcoming school year are for there to be two fourth grade teachers, though the budget allocations were only for one. Additionally, we will maintain three first grade teachers, though allocations only show two. The counselor position will move to a .5 next year. We will retain a .5 social worker. The SST Intervention Specialist position will be abolished. We will have a Turnaround Behavioral Specialist full time that will

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support behavior interventions in the building. The work of the SST position will be a shared role between the Instructional Coaches. A 4-5 EIP position will be abolished. We will gain a .5 art teacher. Our .5 Spanish teacher will be abolished. Students will still receive Spanish through an online program. Receiving our holdback funds will be used to gain a second grade teacher. We will be purchasing a new ELA curriculum for the upcoming school year. The schools are now responsible for funding teacher stipends, professional development sessions, and all instructional resources. Turnaround allocations will be weaned each year. The board will also be reevaluating the Turnaround funds.
