


TOOMER'S OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY SURVEY RESULTS







- Remove collared shirts as a requirement.


DO YOU UNDERSTAND THE CURRENT OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY?

- Suggestions to make a firm decision. Either a yes or no to uniforms and not make it optional.


ARE YOU OPPOSED TO THE OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY?

- An optional policy seems like no policy


IS THE SCHOOL'S OPTIONAL UNIFORM POLICY MESSAGING CLEAR?


- The messaging is not clear, primarily to incoming parents

Feedbad


- The parents that answered No most were aware that the school offered assistance
- The parents that are not aware of uniform assistance would like that information found on the website or handbook and options available to them and who to contact




