IV. Action Items

a. FY 19 Budget

- Principal Crooms invited GO Team and Budget office reps. to assist with clarification concerning the questions presented in the prior meeting. These responses were provided in writing previously to the GO Team by Principal Crooms.
- Ms. Bethea explained that APS is the only district in the state that is utilizing the Student Success Formula (SSF). Modeled after Nashville and Denver.
- SSF is a gradual process based on the formula
- Brown loss funding due to decrease in projected enrollment- Also Brown is the smallest middle school enrollment in district.

- The number of students that are determined to be identified as “poverty” comes directly from the state certification for SNAP/TANF.
- Count is based off of a percentage and applied against the total projected enrollment.
- Leveling on the 15th day. Numbers will be adjusted where funding can increase or decrease.
- GO Team Representative stated that there is a video on the members only site that explains the SSF in more detail. She provided the login information. She also stated that the GO team for approving the budget should focus on ensuring that the priorities from the Strategic Plan are present and that the funds are aligned to those priorities.
- Ms. Crooms requested that a Rationale be provided to the GO Team.
- Motion to vote on the FY19 budget was proposed by Ms. Triplett.
- Motion to vote was approved by Stewart/2nd Maltese
- Brown Middle School Budget was approved unanimously by the Go team.
