- a. **Discussion Item 1:** Family Engagement/Table Talk Feedback Session: Ms. Lee attended the session and summary notes were provided to the team.
- b. **Discussion Item 2:** BMS Stem Implementations: Ms. Crooms provided fall updates which included how STEM is being implemented into daily curriculum, Problem Based Learning Schedule provided to all members
 - **Discussion Item 3:** CCRPI & BMS Data Review: Ms. Crooms presented the data in the framework of a SWOT analysis. Data packet provided included info from Fall SY2020. Ms. Crooms updated the team on factors that impacted enrollment overtime beginning in 2012. For example, Kennedy MS closing and Hollis Innovation Academy opening. Ms. Crooms explained that the student mobility rate is the percentage of students Student mobility – percentage of students enrolled at least 65% out of 180
 - Student mobility for 2019 was 43%
 - Brown receives \$4,586 per student
 - Sub group enrollment – at least 15% of population to comprise a subgroup
 - Current enrollment is 391
 - Behavior update: culture has improved a lot with regards to OSS and ISS Rates
 - Staff attendance is above the district average.
 - Staff retention has improved
 - CCRPI update provided via a chart comparing 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years: 64.3, 66.1 respectively. Ms. Crooms went over each content area and described how it works in the CCRPI rating.
 - Used post-it notes so the team could identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats based on the data presented.
