



<p>What is a School – Parent Compact?</p> <p>What is compact? A compact is a written agreement of how school staff, students and parents will work together to help students achieve. Each school that receives Title I money must have a compact.</p> <p>What is the purpose of a compact? The purpose of a compact is to list specific duties of school staff students, and parents in student learning. With a compact, everyone knows their role. The compact also includes how the school, staff and parents will communicate with each other.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Teachers will develop lesson plans that cover their grade level's content standards. For other school staff, the compact says what they should do to support the teaching of the content standards and student's ability to learn. The principal will make sure the school is safe and secure so that students can focus on learning, free of disturbance and fear. <p>Jointly Developed The parents, staff, teachers and community of STEAM Academy at Carver collaboratively developed this school home compact. Meetings are held bi-annually to review the Compact and make changes based on students' needs. Throughout the school year.</p> <p>As a Parent I will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Attend Parent Workshops offered by STEAM Academy at Carver to better understand the school goals, assessments my students will be taking, and test preparation strategies I can reinforce at home. Ensure my child attends tutorial programs and utilizes online resources in order to receive additional help in preparing for class work and Georgia Milestones. Communicate meaningfully and regularly with my child's teachers regarding his/her progress and additional support needed to meet the goals. Monitor my child's progress using Infinite Campus. Communicate regularly with my student's teachers and provide accurate contact information.


