IV. Discussion Items

a. Discussion Item 1: - Overview Budget Development Process

- FY21 Priorities are to focus on increasing achievement, rigor, and grade level proficiency as well as providing an instructional coach for Social Studies and Science teachers.
- 2% of funds on reserve until enrollment is met.
- All current staff positions remain while adding two additional gifted teachers.
- Total funding from Cares Act is \$342,690
- Money has also been allocated to adding a Community in Schools Staff member and a full-time technology specialists.
- 76% of the FY2022 Budget is specifically for the students and classroom enrichment.
- The 4th Assistant Principal will take on the responsibilities of the IB Coordinator.
- Possibly having local university students stepping in to help students bridge any gaps in their learning formed from the pandemic.

V. Principals Report

- 250 students were registered to return during the 1st phase; however, only about 157 students are present on a daily basis.
- An additional 130 students will return 03.22.2021 during the 2nd Phase.
- All teachers have been awarded air purifiers for the classrooms.
- A Social-distanced recess time has been implemented to allow the students time to decompress and be social.
- New parents/ additional parents needed for the GO TEAM. Recommendations should be brought to the next meeting.
