#### IV. Discussion Items

#### a. Discussion Item 1: BASC-3 Screener

The BASC-3 Screener is a Behavior and Mental Health screener. It helps us determine the type of support our students require. It is administered twice a year. Our Care Team, which is comprised of counselors, school nurse, social worker, school psychologist, MTTS specialist, Student Support Disproportionality Specialist, Graduation Coach, Behavior Interventionalist, Assistant Principals, Principal and After School Program Coordinator uses the data to determine what social and emotional needs we need to address. Behavior, attendance, and grades are also evaluated to determine how they align with BASC-3 Data.

## b. Discussion Item 2: Attendance

Due to increased enrollment King was able to hire an attendance clerk this year. The attendance clerk will focus on increasing attendance by reaching out to parents and providing incentives to



students and classes based on attendance. Dr. Morgan would like to speak to businesses in the community to solicit donations.

#### c. **Discussion Item 3:** Recess

All grades participate in recess. Classes have recess directly before or directly after lunch. Recess is defined as a brain break from instruction. Recess can take place indoors or outside. King has adopted PlayWorks which provides structured play activities. Students do not go outside when temperatures are below 32 degrees. Recess may not take place if there are safety concerns or if the majority of students are not dressed for weather conditions. Some activities may involve screen time, but it will be limited.

## a. Principal's Report

Utilizing current data, the Go Team will review & possibly update the school strategic priorities and plan.

**Current Smart Goals** - The percentage of students in grades 6-8 scoring developing or above in reading will increase from 54% to 58% on Georgia Milestones EOG.

The percentage of students in grades 6-8 scoring developing or above in math will increase from 50% to 54% on Georgia Milestones EOG.

King will use the Universal Behavior Screener twice a year to assess the social and emotional needs of students. King was able to meet their goal of administering the screener to 96% of all students.

**Over Arching Needs** - Focus on increasing the percentages of Black, White, Hispanic, Economically Disadvantaged, English Learner, and Students with Disabilities at Proficient Learner or above on the GMAS EOG in ELA, Reading and Math.

Whole Child & Student Support: Continue to develop a positive, and collaborative environment for teachers, students, and staff that supports social and emotional well-being.

MAP Growth, GMAS, Amplify Unit Assessments Universal Screener Data, Counselor Log Sheets, Counselor Referrals from students and teachers will be used to monitor progress. Data depicts marked differences between student achievement across subgroups. Our focus is to close the gaps across subgroups
