### a. Family Engagement & Communications Advisory Committee

### b. G3 Summit Review

Mr. Cartee had an opportunity to recognize the influence of the Go Team advocating for recess time during the school day. Mrs. Miller mentioned the summit allowed her to see the importance of great work and dedication of a Go Team. Also, the summit exposed her to the many resources utilized at other schools.

## V. Information Items

### a. CCRPI & Milestone Data

Mr. Brown led the Go Team in an overview of the College and Career Readiness Index (CCRPI) data on [http://ccrpi.gadoe.org/Reports/Views/Shared/ Layout.html](http://ccrpi.gadoe.org/Reports/Views/Shared/Layout.html)

King Middle School's 2019 CCRPI score is 70.7. This is an increased overall score of 6.3 from 2018's score. The Go Team reviewed four categories that contribute to the overall CCRPI score; Content Mastery (30%), Progress (35%), Closing Gaps (15%), Readiness (20%). The results for King include: Content Mastery 44.8%, which is a 6.2 gain; Progress 79.1%, which is a 1.0 loss; Closing Gaps 100%, which is 30 point gain; Readiness 20%, which is 1.5 gain.

### b. Staffing & Scheduling Updates

An Introduction to Communication class has been added in connections available to 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup>. The advance class will start second semester, January 2020. The class is currently an exploratory for those students interested.

An eighth grade teacher is currently out on FMLA. During this time, the other 8<sup>th</sup> grade science teacher is collaborating with the long term substitute to ensure students are receiving current instruction.

- a. Mrs. Miller suggested using Playworks as resource for recess. Playworks is national nonprofit that supports learning and physical health by providing safe and inclusive play to low-income students in urban schools. Mr. Brown stated he will look into the cost for the next year's budget.
- b. Mr. Cartee volunteered to participate/lead in APS table talks. The Go Team suggested giving parents a two weeks' notice; possibly a 10:00 am and 5:30 pm session.
- c. Mr. Brown suggest offering suggestions for the next superintendent.
