- a. **Discussion Item 1**: Georgia Milestones Math Data
 - i. Increase from 44% to 53% for students in the red
 - ii. Majority of our students in the Level 1 for contents
 - iii. 17.8% to 16.6% proficiency for Black students
 - iv. 0.4% lose for Hispanic students
 - v. 6th and 8th showed improvement for Math and ELA
 - vi. Declines in 7th Grade students for all contents and 8th Grade students in Social Studies
 - 1. Is there a plan for more growth for our SWD students? Yes, SDI focus for those students and their IEPs; creating and designing instruction to close gaps
 - Emphasis on high quality instruction and needs for the ELL students
 - With Social Studies and Sciences, the emphasize is in strengthening the PLC and teacher planning to mirror Math and FLA
