- 9th grade (2027) - High growth at 21% + growth in ELA - Ms. Joi Tutt shared about the ELA departments' strategic plan to improve literacy and this data is evident from the hard work of the ELA teachers and department chair.
- 10 grade (2026) also displayed growth in ELA on the MAP assessment
- School-wide data shows gains in ELA, and room for gains in mathematics
