IV. Discussion Items

A. 2025-2030 Strategic Plan Development

- i. Uzoka presents APS 3 goals for 2030 (20% increase in 3rd grade ELA Milestones, 8th grade math Milestones, and students meeting CCRPI College and Career Readiness) and key performance indicators (absenteeism, sense of belonging, discipline all students, discipline students with disabilities, discipline black students, student-staff relationships, student success plans, school climate).
- ii. Capelli shares 3 key resources to review: 2020-2025 strategic plan (updated every five years), 2025-2026 continuous improvement plan goals (updated each year), and school data sheet.
- iii. Discussion of Potential Mission Statement updates:
 1. Dass provides feedback on her choice of #3 focusing on strong relationships; McKenzie notes preference for #1 with focus on graduating students ready for college, career, and life; Goodman likes #2's supportive environment.
 2. Jones directs GO Team to examine the KPI summary data that may impact Mission and Vision updates. Discussion of low KPI scores (student-staff relationships, staff engagement, safety perception) led to questions about validity of data and surveys.
 3. GO Team adult members ask student members about their perceptions of validity of percentages.

Draft of Mission Statement: To cultivate lifelong learners ready for college, career, and community life who are confident, capable, and connected through rigorous academics, strong relationships, and responsive student support systems.

- iv. Discussion of Potential Vision Statement updates:
 1. Boyd promotes using #1's concept of dynamic learning environment but substituting community to coincide with Mission Statement; Kastorf suggests including student well-being from #2; Goodman supports high expectations and student voice from #1.

Draft of Mission Statement: To be a dynamic learning community where inclusivity, high expectations, and family collaboration create a student-centered environment that fosters well-being and student voice.
