<p>STUDENT IDs</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Effective in SY2022-23, ALL students are required to wear a visible Student ID at ALL times while on campus. Student IDs will be issued by the school. Lost or damaged IDs must be replaced. <i>Repeated need to replace a student ID may occur a cost—\$5.</i> <p>TOPS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Collared polo-style or button down shirts (any color); M.H. Jackson athletic, club, and class shirts/sweatshirts; Official College & Armed Forces (i.e. Army, Navy) shirts/sweatshirts; Shirts provided at school- or district-related events. <p>BOTTOMS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Khaki-colored or Black Pants, shorts, skorts, or skirts; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Skirts, shorts and skorts must be about 3” above the knee and fall below fingertips; Pants must sit at or above the waistline (no sagging); MJHS Branded Athletic Pants—any color, but must have the MJHS logo/sport. <p>SHOES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriate shoes that fit, have a back, and allow for safe movement throughout the school must be worn at all times; We highly suggest close-toed shoes for your safety <p>ACCESSORIES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Belt, if needed (remember, pants must sit at or above the waistline); No spikes, chains, or potentially dangerous items are allowed as jewelry/accessories; 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Clothing, hairstyles, and jewelry that may cause a disruption or constitute a health or safety hazard; DO NOT WEAR.... <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Bandanas, head wraps, bonnets, hats, or hoods; Tights, leggings, spandex, or similar items as pants; Tank-tops, crop tops, or spaghetti straps as shirts; Pajamas, lingerie, or undergarments as shirts/pants; Footwear without backs—i.e. Slides or Flip-flops; Bottoms that are not Khaki-colored or Black; Dresses (unless approved for school event); Another Student’s ID Clothing should NOT: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Expose midriffs, backs, or backsides; Be excessively tight, short, or revealing; Expose undergarments or underwear; Have excessive tears, rips, or holes; Contain words or symbols that are gang-related, offensive, insulting, sexually suggestive, vulgar, obscene, or promote illegal behavior; Contain words or symbols associated with drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or weapons;
<p>BOOKBAGS/BACKPACKS <i>[All bags are subject to search by school administration.]</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must be CLEAR or MESH (no exceptions) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mesh backpacks have been more durable, in particular ones by brands such as Jansport, Nike, Adidas, and Under Armour; Students may carry a SMALL purse. As a rule of thumb, a purse large enough to hold a binder or textbook is considered a bookbag and is not allowed; Chromebooks/laptops may be secured in a protective sleeve; Non-clear or mesh backpacks will be collected upon entry; Likewise, Athletic Bags will be collected and stored until the end of the day.
