	High-level Overview
Safety Protocols/PPE/ Student Transitions	 All CDC guidelines regarding social distancing will be enforced Temperature checks will be taken upon arrival to school CARE Room has been established to house any students that are exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19 School nurse will be present to assist with healthcare needs PPE will be provided for adults and children as needed Bathroom breaks for students will be scheduled intermittently to minimize traffic Student transitions will be minimized throughout the school day
Nutrition	 Breakfast and Lunch will take place in the classroom based on a distribution schedule that is staggered to accommodate grade level instructional blocks Designated staff will deliver meals to the classroom; teachers will distribute meals to students Sharing of food and/or utensils will be discouraged Hand Sanitizer Stations have been placed in each classroom; Hand sanitizing and handwashing breaks will be embedded in the meal schedule/time
School Instructional Model/Schedule	 We are planning for a phased-in approach to reopening: Students in grades K-2 and Special Education (low incidence) will return on January 25; Students in grades 3-5 will return on February 1 Beginning on January 25, school hours will be 8:00am-2:30pm Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday for both virtual and face-to-face learning models. Asynchronous Wednesday will be held each Wednesday until the end of the school year (May 2021) for students to complete independent learning assignments, homework or engage in small group support with teacher and/or support staff
