- **Discussion Items**

A. One Voice Survey Data Dive

- i. Ms Okulaja shared that we would review the One Voice survey data—that students, parents, and staff take
- ii. The discussion questions: what surprised us the most & what stood out, what instructional practices or supports could help increase engagement & raise the “my teachers make learning interesting” & what areas of excellence are important to highlight to the broader community
- iii. She gave us a few minutes to look over the scholar results
 1. Anything that jumps out at us?
 - a. No one shared
- iv. Ms. O. showed us the percentages of what families shared for questions & gave us a moment to look it over
 1. She shared that families feel communication is on point & does a lot of communication & that families feel that their scholar is supported as a whole child—not just academics
- v. Ms. O shared K-8 staff results for a few questions & compared to the region for each one
 1. She paused to see if anything stood out to anyone
 - a. Ms. Graham shared that on the first slide for scholars—64% said that my teachers make learning interesting and fun and noticed that the energy teachers bring (their tone, their voice, matters). Teachers have to have the same type of energy when you’re in the same class—be hype—if teachers are hype, students will be hype. It’s how we present the material to them
- vi. Ms. O said if she was to share about KWPA she would share that families feel they have strong communication, that their scholars feel supported academically, socially, and emotionally & being able to articulate that in one sentence. She opened the floor to anyone else of what they would share
- vii. Ms. O called on Ms. Crittendon and Ms. Johnson. Ms. Crittendon said it was interesting. She then called on Ms. Johnson—she said that KWPA is always ready to hear her voice & jump on any issue that she may have
