##### 2020-2021-School Priorities

- Increase the percentage of all students in grades K-8 scoring at or within “stretch” Lexile Levels.
- Explicitly teach and actively track students writing products in grades K-8 specifically Students with Disabilities.
- Continue to establish a rich and embedded STEM Culture that uses the Design Thinking Process to solve real-world problems.
- Increase students’ offering beyond the academic block.
