Dr. Jack reviewed 2019 Preliminary Budget

- 73% Instruction
- 8% Improvement of Instructional Services
- 7% School Administration
- 7% Pupil Services
- 3% Educational Media Services
- 2% Maintenance & Operations
- .2% Instructional Staff Training

2019 Budget Staff Projections

- We will have a combined 6th-7th grade team. (Math/ELA 6th grade teacher will teach both 6th and 7th grade students).
- We will add an additional REP teacher(Reading) for 6th-7th grades.
- We will continue accelerated classes for 2018-2019.
- We have 1 Art, PE, World Languages, and Music Teacher for K-5.
- We have 1 Dance Teacher for 2018-2019 through Coca-Cola. (K-7)
- Adding ½ teacher for Art
- Adding 1 Band Teacher (Students will begin band in 2nd grade).
- Adding 1 PE Teacher
- Maintain SEL Coach-Building Positive Environment
- Three STEM Classes will remain
- Continue Partnership and Marketing Position and Media Representative Position
- Funding added for Nurse.

- \$10,000-Transportation for Saturday School (Lunch will also be provided)
