Budget Changes

- Hollis will have a full-time foreign language (Spanish) position
- Middle School- will operate on a 4 week rotation that will allow Reading/Mathematics Intervention
- The goal is to ensure 8th graders will receive high school credit for foreign language

The 2020 Budget includes:

- Pupil Services-8%
- Improvement of Instructional Services-4%
- Instructional Staff Training-1%
- Educational Media Services-1%
- School Administration-7%
- Maintenance & Operations-1%
