 - **S.**T.E.M. Enrichment Experience
 - Construction Ready, partnered with Home Depot, is doing a 6 week program for Hollis students: construction skills, measuring, drilling, math based, problem solving, sanding, hammering, built shadow boxes. Hollis Innovation Academy is currently the only Atlanta Public School participating in this program. Provided real life math applications, supports Hollis' mission and vision for our children to dream bigger and lead choice filled lives
 - Dream Bigger: Funding, improvement to facilities, community support. 11,000 sq ft of space that is the pool that is not being used. Possibly could be a weight room and/or larger gym for middle school, vented space for Construction Ready program with access to outside. Needs: Funding for renovations from APS, external partnerships for capital improvement project, budget for Construction Ready teacher, class materials, and resources.
