- ✓ A set of watercolor paints are needed. *Prang* brand watercolor paints are what we use in the art room and are good quality elementary watercolor paints. Please purchase whatever brand fits your budget.
- ✓ Although a set of watercolors may come with an adequate brush, another flat or round watercolor brush of a different size might prove helpful. Extra bushes are *optional* <u>not</u> required. If they have been in art club before they might already have brushes to use.
- ✓ Watercolor paper. Paper designed for watercolor paint is <u>not</u> required, yet your child will have the "total" watercolor experience using the thicker, watercolor paper. Watercolor paper is usually sold in a bound tablet pad/pack of 15-20 sheets. Once again, watercolor paper is not required.

2. Kroger Popcorn for Hungry Art Clubbers

Please bring a popcorn snack. *Kroger* brand butter popcorn is *preferred* by art clubbers. A box of six bags costs \$2.00. If you desire bring the more expensive popcorn, no problem, the choice is yours. A donated roll of paper towels *or* Clorox disinfecting wipes would be helpful to keep things tidy.
