

Overall Data:

MAP HIGHLIGHTS

13th out of 55 schools for students meeting growth projections across the district 56% of students exceeding growth projections.

Kindergarten:

- 73% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Reading
- 77% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Math

1st Grade:

• 100% Take Rate for Reading and Math MAP

2nd Grade:

- Decrease in Beginning Learners by 16% in Reading
- Increase in Proficient and Distinguished Learners by 5% in Reading
- 65% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Reading
- 58% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Math

3rd Grade:

- Increased Math Proficiency by 8%
- 65% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Math
- 21% of 3rd graders are Proficient or Distinguished in Reading

4th Grade:

- Decrease in Beginning Learners in Reading by 7%
- Increase in Distinguished Learners in Reading by 4%
- 52% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Reading

5th Grade:

- Decrease in Beginning Learners in Math by 4%
- Increase in Proficient Learners in Math by 2%
- Increase in Proficient Learners in Reading by 6%
- 65% of students Met or Exceeded Projected Growth Goal in Reading
