Discussion around whether the Go Team can / should add a priority around staffing prioritization. Per Go Team office, updates to the strategic priorities should occur before the budget process. Discussion that the strategic priorities should reflect academic goals for students whether they are in-person or virtual. Per Ms Sofianos, budget for 2021-2022 is being built based on a 5 day/week face-to-face model. With that in mind, the school will be adequately staffed to support face-toface instruction. CARES II Funding is intended to be used for the 2021-22 year, not the current year. Teachers expressed support for the new positions (Instructional coach and Parent liaison) to help with barriers in reaching parents and to help teachers with resources to reach kids at different levels and any intervention that happens in the classroom.

Information Items

1. Principal's Report - Fourth Quarter face to face and virtual updates; Staffing; Resources

January-March - 60% F2F, 40% virtual (477 students in building)

Beginning March 22nd - 73% F2F, 27% virtual (587 students F2F, 221 students virtual). Second-highest in-person site on one campus. Three elementary schools with higher percent return, but all three have dual campuses.

Working to develop creative ideas. Goal continues to be as many students, as many days as possible. Plan will be presented to the community on Friday.

MES is facing challenges with staffing. They are trying to hire additional permanent subs. There are currently no subs available.

PPE & Supplies: Air purifiers in every room (cost \$6,000)

- Take home tool kits (cost \$13,000)
- Masks available for students and teachers
- District replenishing supplies on Wednesdays
- Face shields purchased for teachers

Hybrid could be used for specific grades, even down to specific teachers within a grade level.

Need to plan based on the resources the school currently has, rather than anticipated resources because the plan needs to be released by Friday.

60% Calculation current understanding from APS is the 60% is based on current enrollment.

Discussion of request received of Go Team to re-examine budget to free up funding for additional staff. Per Go Team Office, once the budget is approved, unless some change is required by APS, there is no process to go back and re-evaluate the approved budget.





Clarifying the role of the Go Team (using Go Team / Principal Roles Information from Orientation) will help clarify the role of the Go Team. Roles of Go Team will be posted to the MES Go Team web site.
