IV. Discussion Items

a. **School Strategic Plan:**

Team briefly discussed the district's new strategic plan and how it relates to the work that will begin on the next meeting to start creating the 2025 – 2030 Strategic Plan for the school. This discussion centered around key takeaways from the G3 GO-Team Summit, specifically the session led by Chief Strategy Officer, Travis Norvell on how GO-Teams should be thinking about how to develop the school level plan.

b. **Data Discussion (MAP):** Anderson led us through an overview of the Fall Map results, comparing Fall 2024 to Fall 2025 results. It highlights that 67% of our students are on or nearing grade level for the 9th grade and 69% of our 10th graders in numeracy and literacy

c. **Data Discussion (GMAS):** Braziel led the conversation on GMAS results from SY25, Proficiency and Distinguished for Am. Lit (10%), Biology (16%), US History (14%), and Algebra 1 (16%). We are below the district average in these areas. Also 50% of our students scored in the bottom 50% of each test. Also, Braziel noted that the Am Lit test was being phased out and replaced with a milestone in Lit & Comp II, moving the ELA milestone from 11th to 10th grade.

V. Information Items

a. **Principal's Report (Construction Updates)** Construction is currently not scheduled to finish until July 2026. Phase 1 (1st Floor) is complete, which includes the Principal's Suite (Principal, School Business Manager) as well as the 1st Floor Office (10th Grade AP, Registrar, 1st Floor Clerk, and Teacher Workroom). Phase 2, the Counseling Suite is underway. Disruptions are being addressed, especially the roof replacement which has impacted parking in the rear of the building.

b. **Principal's Report (Enrollment and Leveling Updates)** The projected enrollment for the school was: 959, after the 15 day headcount the enrollment was: 927. The 32 student deficit came with a budget adjustment of -\$190,784 for the school year. The district did make the decision to hold harmless, meaning the school was able to keep their teachers and staff intact. However, the adjustment will be included in next school year's budget.

c. **APS Forward 2040 –Comprehensive Long-Range Facilities Plan Update** Based on the Sept 22 version of the APS Forward 2040, Carver High School would become a district wide School of the Arts, with their attendance zones being split between B.T. Washington and South Atlanta. Preliminary numbers show that it would take South Atlanta from 927 to nearly 1700 students.
