- a. **Discussion Item 1:** The team viewed the school priorities and discussed how the priorities align with the school mission/vision. For example, including more students to enhance college and career awareness and preparedness; making more students aware of college/career opportunities post high school graduation. The graduation rate from 2024 was 92.2% and it was 87% in 2023. Mr. Springfield shared the usage of the 2027 Graduating Class Google Classroom for students to stay informed.
- b. **Discussion Item 2:** Dr. Ford discussed establishing new Pathways for students interested in workforce development, i.e. heavy machinery. Talent management- 80% of staff retained from last year. Teacher training over the summer is being implemented to build teacher capacity. The school has positive trait with culture and climate due to positive interactions. The school is increasing student attendance by incentivizing attendance, having attendance parties, and addressing students that have chronic absenteeism.
