#### What's in a strategic plan?

Mission, vision, success	<ul> <li>Where do we want to be in 5-10 years? What do we want to see for our students and our community?</li> <li>How will we know we've gotten there? How will we measure what we are doing to determine if it is working?</li> </ul>
PBSA model	<ul> <li>What are the core parts of our model? What are the non-negotiables? What makes us different?</li> <li>What enabling systems do we need in place for our model to work?</li> </ul>
Priorities	<ul> <li>Where is PBSA strong today? Where do we need to improve? How will we know when we've done that?</li> </ul>
Path forward	<ul> <li>Where do we go from here? What's the plan to get us to where we desire to be? Who is responsible for what? What should we be doing?</li> </ul>
